



2022 FOOD VENDOR APPLICATION

We are very proud to present one of the most unique and well-known festivals in the Midwest, the 36th Annual Scottish Festival & Highland Games! This two-day summer celebration offers an extensive array of Scottish and Festival attractions.

The Scottish Festival & Highland Games (in its 36th year) attracts anywhere from 10,000 to 15,000 attendees.

Many activities happen throughout the festival including: Heavy Athletics, Piping & Drumming competitions, Dance Competitions, an Entertainment Rock Stage, a Celtic Marketplace and many, many more. Attendees will be able to purchase admission tickets in advance of the event, but also at the gate the day of the event.

The CHICAGO SCOTS, celebrate Scottish identity on behalf of the Illinois Saint Andrew Society. Established in 1845, the Illinois Saint Andrew Society is the oldest 501(c)3 charity in Illinois. The Society nourishes Scottish identity through service, fellowship, and celebration of Scottish culture. In addition to organizing initiatives to promote Scottish culture, the Society offers a range of elder care services at our Scottish Home and MacLean House. The Society welcomes everyone who is Scottish by birth, by heritage or simply by inclination.

We guarantee that the proceeds from the festival directly support the mission of the Society, Scottish Home, and MacLean House. We strive to ensure that the festival will continue to be Chicago's premiere showcase for Scottish heritage, arts, and culture.

PARTICIPANT PROCEDURES and RULES:

Any vendor wishing to be accepted as a food concessionaire for hot and/or cold food items and/or beverages must adhere to the following rules and policies

APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 20, 2022 – NO EXCEPTIONS

LIABILITY COVERAGE:

- Vendors are **REQUIRED** to obtain and submit a proof of insurance listing CHICAGO SCOTS/Illinois Saint Andrew Society as the additional insured on General Liability Coverage for a maximum of \$1,000,000.00. Proof of this coverage **MUST** be emailed or mailed to Chicago Scots by June 1, 2022. Participation as a vendor at the festival is not allowed without proof of insurance

EXHIBIT SPACE, TABLE and CHAIR RENTAL MUST BE PRE-ORDERED

- If you purchase electric, we supply 1 SO cord to the back of your booth. Concessionaires must supply heavy-duty grounded extension cord to plug into SO cord
- **NOTE:** If you purchase more than one booth space, you will be charged electric for the number of spaces you are renting
- Additional tables/chairs will **NOT** be available for rent the day of the festival
- You **CAN** bring your own tent

SET-UP TIME SLOTS and EXPECTATIONS

- Friday, June 17th between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. or Saturday, June 18th between 6:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. You will be asked to schedule your set-up time prior to the festival

UPON ARRIVAL:

- **FIRST** – ALL Vendors must check in at the Vendor Check-In Tent located at the private Vendors only entrance. Located near 333 Pierce Rd. Enter parking lot from Windsor Drive.

AT VENDOR CHECK-IN:

Admission tickets – it will be your responsibility to make sure tickets for employees arriving separately be delivered to the Admission Gate Will Call

- Site Map
- Vendor Parking Pass – valid to unload and park ONE refrigerated or food truck/trailer behind your exhibit space
- **NOTE:** Additional vehicles will need to pay for parking in the main parking lot
- For each 15' x 15' exhibit space, you will receive:
 - Two (2) admission tickets (\$25.00 value each)
 - One (1) complimentary parking/unloading pass (\$5.00 value)
 - If you purchase a space larger than 15' x 15', you will be issued one extra admission ticket and one additional parking pass per each additional space

UNLOADING/SET-UP:

- **ACCESS** to the Vendor only road will be granted during set-up and take-down times **ONLY**. Vehicles will NOT be permitted to drive on grass areas of the festival ground unless authorized by festival officials
- You will not have access to drive beyond the Admission Gate Friday after 1 p.m., Saturday between 7:30 a.m. and 7:15 p.m., and after the completion of the Closing Ceremonies. Security will be on-site!

LODGING INFORMATION:

- Discounted hotel rooms for June 17th and June 18th will be available at several local hotels, including two on the festival ground. Please see the LODGING information tab on the Scottish Festival & Highland Games website: www.chicagoscots.org
- Overnight campers are not permitted. Nearest campground – Blackwell Forest Preserve in Warrenville, IL.

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS:

- **WATER and SODA SALE PROHIBITED** – vendors will **NOT** be permitted to sell water and/or soda products of ANY KIND at this festival
- **IF YOU SELL CONSUMABLE GOODS**, contact the Sanitarian at the DuPage County Health Department by June 1, 2022, located at East Public Health Center – 1111 East Jackson Street, Lombard, IL. www.dupagehealth.org
- The Health Department will determine your Food Service Permit fee. Send your completed Food Service Permit Application and payment directly to the DuPage County Health Department no later than 14 days prior to the event!
- **HEALTH DEPARTMENT and FIRE DEPARTMENT** regulations must be met by all concessionaires. Failure to comply with regulations and/or service of unapproved menu items

may cause a vendor to be closed by inspectors from either department. If you are selling on Friday, have your booth ready for inspection by Friday at 1:00 p.m., for all others on Saturday prior to 8:00 a.m.

- **FLAME PROOF CERTIFICATE** – all tents and awnings to have a “flame-proof” certificate, preferably sewn onto the tent material (if bringing your own tent)
- **ALL COOKING and PROPANE** must be 10’ outside of tents
- **EXTINGUISHER** – each vendor must have a K Type Extinguisher
- **WATER** – running potable water is supplied as required by the Health Department. Water hook-up is communal and no individual vendor may use or interfere with the water supply to the detriment of other vendors
- **DEEP FRYING** – Concessionaires are responsible for storage of fryer fat and/or oils in covered containers. You must remove fryer fats/oils from festival ground when vacating booth. Deep fryers are NOT ALLOWED under any part of your tent or awnings
- **CONCESSIONAIRES WILL NOT BE GRANTED EXCLUSIVE RIGHT** to sell or market any particular food or beverage product at the festival. Concessionaires are prohibited from selling all alcoholic beverages, any soda products, Gatorade or water
- **ICE** will be available for sale to concessionaires on Friday from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m. and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- The concessionaire shall be liable for any damage caused to the property. Concessionaires are required to dispose of trash, boxes, etc. in the large dumpsters. Your area must be cleared of all personal trash and will be inspected and documented via photograph at the conclusion of the festival. Violators will receive a \$300 invoice post-event
